Prerequisites

Perimeter attendee (3 day course)

Procedures Covered in Training

Gallagher Perimeter Network Course for certified fence installers is a three day course covering the following procedures and skills.

 - Pulse synchronisation
- **Command Centre Install Procedure**
 - Pre-installation requirements
 - Command centre installation
- **Configure the Command Centre environment**
 - Calendars and Schedules
 - Operator Groups
 - System Alarm Zones
- **Creating Hardware within Command Centre**
 - Monitoring alarms and events
 - Bringing Controllers online
 - Creating hardware devices (Fence Controller, Keypad, Taut Wire Sensors)
- **Monitoring the system**
 - Associating configurations to the keypad/s
 - Monitoring and control of the system through the keypad/s
 - Operator console monitoring
- **Access**
 - Configuring door/s
 - Setting up access (including card types and access groups)
 - Creating action plans
- **Site plans**
 - Configuring site plans
 - Configuring Macros
- **Reports and utilities**

 - Database utilities
 - Troubleshooting
 - **Command Centre Client**
 - Overview
 - Understanding the operation method
 - Configuring operator screens
